

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
ALASKA SOCIETY OF INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is: ALASKA SOCIETY OF INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS.

ARTICLE II

The Corporation's principle office in the State of Alaska is located at 121 West Fireweed, Anchorage, Alaska 99503.

ARTICLE III

The nature of the business, or objects or purposes to be transacted, promoted, or carried on are:

To unite and promote cordial relations among all Independent Accountants, to collect through research and to disseminate generally by all appropriate means, all fundamentally sound accounting theories and practice and methods; to develop, improve, and extend the standards and practice of all independent accountants in Alaska and in any locality where similar groups meet.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall not have any capital stock and shall not be conducted for profit. It is a nonprofit corporation. It shall have the right to collect dues, levy assessments, and do any other activities incidental to carrying out the objectives of the Alaska Society.

ARTICLE V

The names and places of residence of the incorporators are as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The Corporation shall have a perpetual duration.

ARTICLE VII

The private property of the members shall not be subject to the payment of Corporate debts.

ARTICLE VIII

Section 1. The membership of the Alaska Society of Independent Accountants shall be as follows: Active Members, Associate Members, Student Associate Members, and Inactive Members.

Section 2. The qualifications of members of the Society shall be in accordance with standards prescribed by the By-Laws of the Society.

Section 3. The rights, privileges and obligations of membership in the Society, and the remedies for the violation of such, shall be prescribed in the By-Laws of the Society.

ARTICLE IX

The governing body of the Society shall be its Board of Governors who shall be elected by the members of the Society in accordance with the procedures prescribed by the By-Laws of the Society.

ARTICLE X

The seal of the Society shall be a band or scroll on which shall be inscribed “Alaska Society of Independent Accountants” and within the band or scroll shall be the word “Seal”.

ARTICLE XI

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provision contained in this Certificate of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by Statute, and all rights conferred upon members herein are granted subject to this reservation. Amendments to these Articles may be at any Annual convention. The Corporation may, in its By-Laws, confer powers upon its Board of Governors in addition to the powers specifically conferred herein, and in addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon it by statute.
